At Thringstone, we believe children learn best when they feel safe, seen and supported.

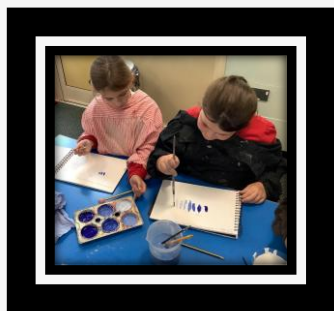
Our SEND provision is inclusive and flexible, with skilled staff who adapt learning and nurture wellbeing.

Little Acorns Pre-School

Our on-site pre-school gives children a brilliant start. With nurturing staff and a play-based approach, Little Acorns helps children grow in confidence, independence and curiosity, ready for a smooth transition into school.



Reception Admissions



We are a one-form-entry school with a close-knit, welcoming feel. Some year groups are taught in mixed-age classes to meet the needs of every learner.

Wraparound Care

Our wraparound care runs from 7:30am to 5:30pm (5pm on Friday's) from the school hall. Breakfast Club is run by school staff, offering a calm, friendly start to the day with food, games and quiet time.

After-school provision is delivered by an external provider Monday to Thursday and by school staff on Friday's, with snacks, play and activities in a familiar setting.
